Additional users will result in additional fees based on the rates above. It is expressly understood by Licensee that the annual Licence Fee is based on the permitted use and Licensee shall inform Licensor of any changes requiring the payment of new or additional Licence Fees.

No concurrent usage or access code sharing is permitted. After the initial term, Licensor may increase the applicable Licence Fee by a maximum of 10% per year, exclusive of any applicable taxes. The stated Licence Fee is exclusive of value added or other taxes or duties and the Licensee shall pay such taxes or duties in addition to the Licence Fee in full and without deduction of any kind.

Licensed Materials: The "World-Check" reference database made available by Licensor to Licensee's authorised users at the following web address: www.world-check.com. The Licensed Materials shall be made available online from the Licensor's web address and any such materials or print-outs, copies or other derivatives thereof shall be deemed to be Licensed Materials for the purposes of this Agreement. The Licensed Materials exclude all materials created by or belonging to third parties contained within or accessible via the "World-Check" database, in particular underlying information sources accessible by means of a link from "World-Check".

Scope and Term of Licence: Licensee agrees that the Licensed Materials shall only be used by individual authorised users to whom Licensor has granted access. The Licensed Materials shall be used by Licensee to screen customer accounts and transactions in connection with Licensee's compliance, due diligence and "know-your-customer" checks. The Licensed Materials may not be used other than to assist Licensee's legal and compliance checks. The Licensee shall ensure that all use of information by it complies with applicable law.
